#### State Cup Seeding Guideline

- 1) Previous years State champion and finalist will be seeded 1 & 2 provided the meet requirement for returning team and are playing Region III
- 2) Seeding will be determined by points only
- 3) Will use 3 point system (3 for win, 1 for tie, 0 for lose)
- 4) If teams play both fall and spring best season will be used to determine points
- 5) If playing in I-10 league only points from four(4)in State games will count
- 6) If playing up, points from league play will be used to determine seeding within State Cup age group.
- 7) If playing as an alternate in Region III RPL, only state league games will be counted as teams will still play a full schedule.
- 8) Only previous years semi-finalist can request to play up in league play or fill an alternate Region III RPL slot, provided they meet requirements of a returning team
- 9) Tie breakers will be the same as in State Cup Rules

#### State Cup qualifying changes

1. There are no play-in games. A maximum of eight (8) teams in an age group can qualify to compete in State Cup. Teams will qualify for State Cup based on their seeding at the completion of State League. Teams not qualifying for State Cup because of their seeding will have their entry fee refunded.
2. If nine (9) or more teams register for an age group only the top eight (8) seeded teams will qualify to compete in State Cup.
3. If seven (7) teams register for an age group only the top six (6) seeded teams will qualify to compete in State Cup.
4. If five (5) teams register for an age group only the top four (4) seeded teams will qualify to compete in State Cup.

Four teams or less, all will qualify.

**DII U13 Spring State Cup will now be played over two weekends beginning May 2012.**

#### Club Pass changes

1. May club pass an unlimited number of players up (i.e. DIII player to a DI or DII team, or DII player to DI team)
2. No players may be club passed down (i.e. DI player to a DII team)
3. There is a lateral club pass limit of 3 players (i.e. 3 DI players to another DI team or 3 DII players to another DII team)
4. **If a player is playing up, that player is not allowed to club pass down to age eligible teams within club**

SHOULD A TEAM NOT BE AVAILABLE TO PLAY A MAKE UP GAME DURING THESE DATES, THEIR TEAM BOND WILL BE FORFEITED AND POSSIBLY STATE CUP ELIGIBILITY WILL BE AFFECTED UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY AYSA. BOTH TEAMS WILL TAKE A LOSS.**

#### **PLAYING TWO GAMES IN ONE DAY**

DIVISION II STATE LEAGUE TEAMS

ONLY U11-18 can schedule two matches in one day for the **travel teams outside their travel area** with a maximum of two games per weekend. (Birmingham to Huntsville – Mobile to Auburn – Auburn to Birmingham) **NOT** Trussville to Hoover or Mountain Brook to Sportsblast or Huntsville to Madison.
